An ancient clone of Verdicchio from one of our oldest vineyards, and - for the first time - the fermentation in ten new barriques. This gave life to this wine that is unique in richness and complexity.

The first vintage 2019 counts just 3.000 bottles, a small niche of production where we concentrated all our energies and attention.

Type of Soil

Medium density, with exposure to the East and Southeast at an altitude of 250 m. above sea level

Wine-making

Winemaking, fermentation, and aging in new barriques for 18 months

To the Eye

Intense, consistent, and crystalline yellow, with golden reflections

To the Nose

Complex on the nose with elegant floral scents. Sweet notes mix with almond and buttery notes, then meet slightly citrus mineral notes and merge into an extraordinary bouquet of unusual richness and intensity

To the Taste

Opulent and concentrated on the palate, very sapid, with a nice sweetness and excellent length and persistence. In the end has notes of toasted almond
